

Take advantage of the good weather and have your very own teddy Bears Picnic over the summer. Get the children to bring their favourite teddy bear for the day. Spend the morning reading goldilocks and the tree bears and making lunch. You could have honey flavoured sandwiches or get a bear shaped cookie cutter and cut out shaped sandwiches. Spread your lunch outside on a picnic rug and eat with your teddies. Afterwards you could have a treasure trail that the children can follow in the garden or a scavenger hunt.

Make your own Jigsaw Puzzles

You need.

Card board (old cereal boxes)
Bright colourful pictures from magazines
Glue
Scissors
Pencil

What to do.

Get the children to choose pictures they like out of some magazines. Glue the picture onto the (shiny side if using a cereal box) card. Wait for it to dry.

Once dry get the children to draw jigsaw shapes onto the card side of the picture.

Once they have done this either you or the children (depending on age) can cut out the jigsaw shapes.

Once cut out get the children to put the picture back together again then swap jigsaws with the other children.
